A proctored exam alternative is made available for students at a geographic distance of 50 miles or more from campus. |
| Hybrid      | Hybrid classes are a combination of in-person and online coursework.<br><b>Hybrid courses are designated with a * in the meeting days.</b>   |

| Registration Terms             |   |

| Term                           | Definition  |
| CRN                            | It is the 5-digit course registration number specific to the class in which you are trying to register for or are currently enrolled.   |
| Course Subject and Number      | Courses are displayed by subject abbreviation (prefix) and course level (ex. ENGL 1101 for English Composition). This aids in searching for classes.  |
| Pre-Requisite and Co-Requisite | Condition that a student is required to meet in order to be eligible for enrollment in a course or program. Pre-requisites must be completed prior, and co-requisites must be taken simultaneously. |
