In-Person	All class sessions meet face-to-face.				
Online	100% online courses are those courses that do not require any on campus visits or proctored exams. 95% online courses will have one on-campus requirement, typically an orientation or exam. A proctored exam alternative is made available for students at a geographic distance of 50 miles or more from campus.				
Hybrid	Hybrid classes are a combination of in-person and online coursework. Hybrid courses are designated with a * in the meeting days.

Term	Definition					
CRN	It is the 5-digit course registration number specific to the class in which you are trying to register for or are currently enrolled.					
Course Subject and Number	Courses are displayed by subject abbreviation (prefix) and course level (ex. ENGL 1101 for English Composition). This aids in searching for classes.					
Pre-Requisite and Co-Requisite	Condition that a student is required to meet in order to be eligible for enrollment in a course or program. Pre-requisites must be completed prior, and co-requisites must be taken simultaneously.
